Section 2: Conditions of Sale:

Seller guarantees that at the time of delivery, the puppy is in excellent health. Should the puppy be found to be in poor health, of a serious nature, Seller will provide Buyer with a replacement puppy from another litter or a full refund of the purchase price of the puppy only. Shipping fees will not be refunded.

The following conditions apply to the sale of the aforementioned dog:

- A. The Buyer has five (5) days from the time of receipt of dog to have dog examined by a Veterinarian. Any request to return the puppy to the Seller for a full refund must be made within this time period and may only be requested should the puppy prove to be sick upon arrival. Proof of examination must be provided.
- B. A warranty against all serious life altering genetic disease is provided until dog is two years of age. Should a genetic disease be discovered during this time, that will greatly shorten the life of, or greatly alter the quality of life of the puppy, Seller will reimburse veterinary treatments for this condition, but will not exceed the purchase price. Seller will offer reimbursement for treatments, not exceeding the purchase price only if:
 - Proof of examination and diagnosis must be provided to Seller and Seller's vet.
 - The Buyer must contact the Seller prior to completing the treatments. A detailed quote including condition, possible reasons, treatment options must be presented to Seller prior to treatment
 - If the reasons of condition are other than genetic, the Seller is not deemed responsible for treatment cost
 - Reference number and name of Pet Insurance company must be provided to Seller in order for Seller to work with the company regarding coverage and cost
- B. A warranty for Hip Dysplasia is provided for two years. This warranty will be terminated should dog be allowed to become overweight or developing joints be overstressed at any point during the first two years. Should dog be found to have Hip Dysplasia within its first two years, Buyer must provide Seller with proof in the form of documentation from PennHIP or OFA. Veterinary medical records will be required showing the weight of dog and veterinarians assessment of the weight. We reserve the right to confirm the results before a replacement or refund is provided. Should results from OFA / PennHIP indicate that an injury may have occurred that caused or contributed to the issue, no reimbursement or replacement will be provided.
- C. We do strive to produce a certain look but we do not guarantee size, color, or appearance.
- D. Under no circumstances shall the Seller be liable to the Buyer or to any third party for any consequential, incidental or special damages resulting from or in a manner related to the puppy.
- E. Upon execution of this contract all veterinary care and its associated costs are the sole and exclusive responsibility of the Buyer.
- F. We require that you have your puppy spayed or neutered within the first 8 months of their birth date. Failure to do so or to provide documentation to this affect by the age of 9 months will void the health guarantee and could possibly result in legal proceedings.

Section 3: Maintenance

Buyer agrees to maintain this dog in good health, provide routine preventative health care including, but not limited to, inoculations and internal and external parasite treatments for fleas, tick & heartworms. If any of the above preventative care has not been provided, health warranty will be void. Buyer also agrees to provide, at minimum, basic obedience training for dog. Although Designer Dogs are known to have wonderful temperament; temperament cannot be guaranteed. Buyer understands that all puppies exhibit certain undesirable behaviors (nipping, chewing, barking, marking, etc). Buyer is responsible for appropriate training of puppy to correctly teach acceptable behaviors, and is responsible for proper socialization of puppy. Should Buyer not be successful at training these behaviors on their own, Buyer agrees to seek professional help from a certified trainer should it become necessary.

Section 4: Full and Final Agreement

Both Buyer and Seller agree that this Purchase Agreement represents the entire Agreement between them and that no other representations have been made regarding the puppy described above.
